

## Grant Application

### Important Dates

January 31      Deadline for receipt of applications  
March 31        Notification of results to applicants

### Number and Amount of Awards

Grants normally are given in amounts ranging from a few hundred to a few thousand dollars. On average, fewer than 20 grants are awarded annually. The competition is keen. We do not fund “hands-on” or humane education projects. Preference will be given to applicants who do not depend on other sources of external funding.

### Grant Preparation

- Enclose a resume or curriculum vitae with your application, as well as any other material (e.g., slides, reviews) that you feel strengthen your application.
- Arrange to have two letters of support sent by the January 31 deadline. Ensure that your supporters enclose a copy of their curriculum vitae.
- Include a detailed description of your project explaining both why you need our support and how you will use the grant.

### Post-Grant Obligation

We ask that should you be awarded a grant you submit a report summarizing your work and how your grant was used. Deadline for reports is November 1.
